#### PREPOPIK FOR YOUR COLONOSCOPY PREP

#### DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- 1. Drink only CLEAR LIQUIDS ALL DAY. NO SOLIDS. There are some suggestions below.
- 2. Starting anytime after 5 p.m., pour ONE (1) packet of Prepopik into the mixing cup. Add cold water to the fill line (5 oz) on the container. Stir 2-3 minutes until completely dissolved. Drink the entire contents within 5 minutes. You can expect MANY bowel movements to start within the next hour.
- 3. Follow with FIVE (5) more 8 oz. containers of water or clear liquid over the next 5 hours before bed at your own pace. This is very important to avoid dehydration.

### MORNING OF THE PROCEDURE:

Approximately 5 hours prior to your scheduled procedure time, repeat step 2 drinking the second dose. Follow with THREE (3) 8 oz. glasses of clear liquid. You should have no more liquid within 4 hours of your procedure *start* time. (Example: if your procedure start time is 1:00 p.m., then you should have no more liquids after 9:00 a.m.)

(It is preferred that you take the  $2^{nd}$  dose the morning of the procedure, but if you have a very early arrival time, you can take both doses of Prepopik the day before:  $1^{st}$  dose should be taken at 4:00 p.m. and  $2^{nd}$  dose should be taken at 10:00 p.m.)

\*\*\*IF YOU FEEL YOUR COST/COPAY FOR PREPOPIK IS TOO HIGH, THERE IS AN ALTERNATE METHOD WE CAN CHANGE YOUR PRESCRIPTION TO THAT IS LESS EXPENSIVE, HOWEVER, IT INVOLVES A LOT MORE TO DRINK\*\*\*

<u>CLEAR LIQUIDS ALLOWED:</u> Water, Gatorade, clear fruit juice, strained soups, bouillon, broth, plain jello, popsicles, Italian ice, sprite, or coke. Coffee and Tea are allowed with sugar, hot or cold, but NO MILK OR CREAMER. No liquid with red dye.

NO SOLID FOODS, MILK OR TOMATO PRODUCTS, OR ORANGE JUICE ALLOWED.

<u>Medications:</u> The day BEFORE the procedure, take your medications as you normally do. The day OF the procedure, we recommend taking the medications AFTER the procedure. Exception: If you are on blood pressure meds, please go ahead & take that medication as early as possible the morning of procedure with a *small* amount of water.
